VTOS – Vocational Training Opportunities Scheme

Vocational Training Opportunities Scheme consists of a range of courses designed to meet the educational and training needs of unemployed people.

VTOS offers the opportunity to return to full-time education while still retaining Department of Social Protection Payment.

· Courses from NFQ Level 3 to Level 5.

Who can join the scheme?

- · People over 21 years of age.
- Be receipt of an eligible payment from the Department Economic Affairs and Social Protection for at least 6 months.
- · Course duration 12 to 24 months.

Local Training Initiative (LTI)

MSLETB in collaboration with local community groups throughout Mayo, Sligo and Leitrim provide flexible Local Training Initiatives (LTIs) for unemployed people.

The LTI programme is aimed at learners who are unable to participate in other training opportunities for personal, social or geographic reasons.

LTIs are designed for people who are:

- · Anyone who is unemployed and over the age of 16, at any level of literacy, is eligible to participate.
- · Primarily people under 35 years of age.
- Have no formal qualifications or incomplete secondary level qualifications.
- · Courses are full-time and are delivered all year round.

LTIs are engaged in a wide range of initiatives including Catering, Genealogy, Heritage, Business, Multi Media, and Sports and Coaching. Some LTI projects are group based.

Training on Local Training Initiatives can lead to accreditation at NFQ Levels 3, 4 and 5.

Adult Basic Education

The Adult Basic Education Service provides literacy and numeracy tuition in a supportive environment for adults who need to develop their skills in reading, writing, spelling, maths and using everyday technology.

- Tuition is offered on a one-to-one or small group basis with the option of gaining a nationally recognised qualification.
- Intake is ongoing for most courses, however some are limited to September intake only.
- · Welcomes Learners of all ages and backgrounds.
- · Educational Assessment is confidential.
- The service is free of charge.

English as a Second Other Language (ESOL)

- Offers English language classes to speakers of other languages the opportunity to learn English from beginners to NFQ Level 3 up to Level 5.
- · Intake September and January.
- · Courses are free.

BTEI - Back to Education Initiative

The Back to Education Initiative provides opportunities to return to learning for young people and adults.

- Anyone who has left full time education can take part in a course being offered, but priority will be given to those with less than upper second level education.
- Fees will not be charged to those who are in receipt of a Social Welfare payment.
