Voting Procedures -

- 1. Casting of Votes will take place by online voting from Monday 14th Sept to Monday 21st Sept at 5 pm and counting of votes will take place after the close of poll.
- 2. On Sligo Disability Consultative Committee there is <u>ONE</u> seat available and **Two** eligible candidates.

Therefore a ballot will be taken.

The person voting on behalf of the group MUST BE the Primary or Alternative contact for the group as registered with Sligo PPN. Any votes made by any other member will not be accepted.

- 3. Voters are asked to select **ONE** candidate only.
- 4. In the event of a tie, the successful candidate will be determined by lot. The first candidate drawn out will be deemed to be elected.
- 5. Candidates who are unsuccessful but have obtained at least one vote will be deemed 'substitute' in the event that the successful nominee resigns his or her seat over the lifetime of the Committee.
- 6. Officers will be appointed by Sligo County Council to endorse the final ballot count.
