Largest ever investment by an Irish Government in tree-planting

Premiums for planting trees to be increased by between 46% and 66% and extended to 20 years for farmers

FT3 - Forests on Public Lands

- Native Woodlands on State land
- Climate Action Plan
- Establishment Grant
- Facilities Grant (trails, seats, signs)
- Forest playground Grant
- No forest premium





Cloonamahon Native Woodland Park

Largest project of this scale in the country

Accessibility element very important Collaborative project between:

- Western Forestry Co-operative –
 forest managers and neighbouring landowner
- Coillte Neighbouring landowner
- Sligo County Council Amenity, recreation, tourism





Cloonamahon Native Woodland Park


Phase 1

 105 acres Native Woodland, 4km trails, picnic areas, seating, forest playground, Habitat & Info signs

Phase 2

- HSE Native Woodland Conservation
- WFC Model Forest
- Coillte replant with native woodland & amenities
- Sligo CoCo amenity plans Link to Collooney Greenway, New Cycleway to Collooney due to N4 upgrade







FT4 - Amenity Forests & Neighbourwoods

- Creation of new woodland for recreation
- Private landowners partnering with communities
- Establishment & Facilities Grant (max 12ha)
- Forest premium €1,142 (15 or 20 yrs)
- Neighbourwood Plan (scale important)
- Example 6 ha (15 acres)
 - Land price €8-10k per acre €120-150k
 - Forest premium 15 years €102,780 bridging finance



Proposed FP Interventions

- 6. Open Forests: Social, cultural & heritage forests (existing forests max 12 ha)
 - NeighbourWoods, forest classroom, Heritage





Balla Neighbourwood Woodland Operations & Facilities

- 1. 4 bay Car park
- 2. 650m of new path and 530m upgrade to existing path
- 3. 3 Picnic benches, 4 seats, woodland grove
- 4. Signage Information signs, woodland habitat signs
- 5. Tree Trail of 15 trees
- 6. Wildlife Bat and Owl boxes
- 7. Fairy Village



FT 8 - Creation of Agroforestry Systems

Silvopastoral, Silvoarable, Forest Gardening





Native Tree Area Scheme (Farmers)

Small scale planting of native trees without an afforestation licence

Two Types:

NTA 1 - Creation of small native forests

Establishment of new native forests on farmed land


NTA 2 - Creation of native forests for water protection

Native forests and undisturbed water setbacks to

protect and enhance water quality

Native Tree Area Scheme Premiums over 10 years:

- €2,206 per ha annually for NTA1
- €2,284 per ha annually for NTA2








